Applicants are then screened regarding their collective achievements, and the academic committee submits its recommendations to the Ministry to award scholarships according to the number currently available.

Scholarship and Fellowship Support

The King Abdullah Scholarships provide generous financial support for scholarship recipients. Among the privileges it offers are the following:

- Monthly stipend
- Full tuition and fees paid directly to the educational institution
- Cost of attending conferences/symposiums/workshops
- Expenses for scientific trips
- Allowances for books & clothes
- Financial support for spouse and dependents
- Medical insurance

In order to ensure that they have been adequately prepared, the Ministry offers the nominees the opportunity to study the language of instruction prior to the commencement of the study for a period of between a few months and one year, depending on the candidate's need.
